

2022 Clay Sportsman Club Indoor Shooting Rules:

1. All teams will consist of two people and must be fully paid for the season by Week 3.
 - League will begin January 11th, 2022
 - Tues/Wed night leagues will be condensed to one league with two shooting nights.
2. League will run 10 weeks and will be \$100.00 per person.
3. Each week shall consist of 60 arrows, shot as three games, at a distance of 20 yards. Each game shall consist of four ends of five arrows per end.
4. No equipment restriction. Shoot what you have.
5. An archer must straddle the shooting line or distance marker. A disabled archer shooting from a chair or wheelchair will place the chair legs or wheels straddling the shooting line or distance marker.
6. There will be top and bottom lines,
 - teams will hang their targets on the same side,
 - bottom line will start the round.
7. Scoring:
 - The scoring is 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 from the spot out on the single spot and 5, 4, 0 on the 5-spot
 - **X-rings shall be counted and used as tie breakers and will be considered part of the official score. The method of breaking ties will be X count.**
 - Archer shall record X's and numeric values of each arrow in each scoring box before touching or drawing any arrows from the target

Example:

Arrow Score End Score X's

X X X 5 5 25 3

X X X X 5 25 4

X X X X X 25 5

X X X X 4 24 4

8. Scoring shall be five points for the combined X-ring and white ring four points for the combined blue rings.

9. An arrow cutting two rings shall be scored in the ring of greater value. Scoring is determined by the position of the shaft. In all NFAA Rounds, an arrow shaft need only touch the line to be counted in the area of next higher value.

10. In the event the scoring ring has become distorted due to torn or missing paper, the scorer shall visually reconstruct the natural arc of the scoring ring to determine the value of the arrow(s).

11. Witnessed bounce outs or arrows passing completely through the target will be reshot.

12. Hits on the wrong target will be scored as misses.

13. When an arrow is dropped while the archer is in the act of shooting, he/she may shoot another arrow in place of the dropped arrow if any portion of the dropped arrow is within ten feet of the shooting line. If the arrow passes the line it will be considered a miss.

14. When using the NFAA Indoor Five Spot Target:

An archer may shoot the 5 spot target in any order and shoot as many arrows into any spot as the archer desires, not to exceed the prescribed number of arrows per end.

15. Handicaps will be used, max score with handicap will be 300. Handicap will be based of your scoring

- Individual handicap will be computed at 80% of the difference between an archer's average scratch score and perfect. These handicap points will be given to each individual before a series begins. Handicap's will start after the archer has 3 rounds of scoring recorded.

16. Each week will be a Team vs. Team. The Team with the higher total will get the Win for the week. Standings will be based off of wins/losses.

17. Awards will be for: 1st Place /2nd Place/ 3rd Place/ High Average/ Most Improved

18. At the end of the season there will be a team dinner, trophy presentation and sweatshirts or jackets for the shooters.

19. Make-ups must be completed and turned in no later than the following league night or will result in a Zero.

20. Non Members must be accompanied by a current member when using the range on a non-league time.

21. No drinking in the basements on league nights.
